With respect to charter schools, a June 27, 2013 Memorandum from the Florida DOE states, "...if a student has selected a full-time choice option within the school district, such as a magnet program [or charter program], the school district [or charter school] may condition the student's continued enrollment in that choice option upon maintaining full-time enrollment." This means that students who choose to enroll in Renaissance Charter School at Cooper City may only select from the virtual classes that we offer. Staying within our school's curriculum offerings will ensure that the student maintains his/her "full-time" enrollment status and will ensure that the student maintains integrity with the choice options offered by Renaissance Charter School at Cooper City.
